

## A SHARED RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE A NEW START TOGETHER, SAFELY

### 1) CONDITIONS TO WORK AT THE FAIR

---

*These conditions apply to all Artigiano in Fiera staff, all exhibitors and their collaborators in the stands, regardless of their role, and all direct suppliers.*

- MANDATORY PERSONAL PASS**

All operators, exhibitors and their collaborators in the stands will be equipped with a mandatory Personal pass, which they must carry with them everywhere for identification and access to the fair. There will be continuous checks, also on the part of the competent authorities.
- COVID FREE TEST**

To obtain the Pass, it will be necessary to submit, prior to the first access to the fair, certification confirming that a molecular or antigen test has been carried out in the last 72 hours with a negative result. Those who have not yet been tested can do so at their own expense in a designated area of the fair. Access to the halls will not be granted without this certification. The certification process of foreign countries shall be agreed upon case by case.
- TEMPERATURE CHECK**

All exhibitors, their collaborators and all direct suppliers will have their temperature checked at the entrance to the fair.
- FACE MASK**

All exhibitors, their collaborators and all direct suppliers must wear a mask at all times.
- DISPLAY AND SALE OF PRODUCTS**

All legal regulations must be strictly followed, in particular in relation to rules for the display and sale of all types of products; each stand must be sanitised every single day in accordance with current regulations.



## 2) CONDITIONS TO VISIT THE FAIR

---

*These conditions apply to all those who visit Artigiano in Fiera during the opening times to the public.*

### A) HOW WILL IT BE POSSIBLE TO REACH THE FAIRGROUNDS

- **By car**  
About 3,000 new parking spots have been allocated either inside or next to the Fairgrounds and the cost of parking has fortunately been reduced to a fixed rate of € 6 per day. A total of 13,000 parking spots will be available.
- **Public transport (trains and metro)**  
As at today, the authorities have guaranteed up to 80% of total capacity.
- **Private organised buses**  
An innovative solution offering new routes to the fair thanks to the introduction of special and safe buses.

All these means of travel will be broadly promoted and communicated: it has never been this simple and easy to reach the fair.

### B) HOW WILL VISITORS ACCESS THE FAIR

- Each visitor, in compliance with legal regulations in force, must necessarily indicate their day of arrival at the fair and the time range of their visit (from 9.45am to 3.00pm or from 3.00pm to 11.00pm). This will allow visitor flows to be predicted and efficiently managed, thus avoiding and correcting any peaks. All visitors will therefore receive a Free and personal pass to access the event. For all last year's visitors who have already registered by email, this operation will be very simple.
- Each visitor will have their temperature checked, in addition to the other now standard safety checks.
- All visitors must always wear a face mask.

### C) REORGANISATION OF FAIRGROUND SPACES

- The entries and exits to the halls will be separate to avoid gatherings.
- The main internal aisles leading to the halls have been widened to up to 5 metres, thus allowing current social distancing laws to be respected.
- Hand sanitiser dispensers will be distributed throughout the halls.
- All areas will be regularly sanitised.
- Particular attention will be afforded to cleaning, sanitisation and use of public bathrooms.
- Eateries will be enlarged and spaces will be organised so as to comply with current regulations.
